Changes from Year 2022 data

The last batch of Census 2021 was released by Statistics Canada on November 30, 2022. In our current updates, we have incorporated all components of Census 2021.

Since Census 2021 was conducted during COVID-19, crisis management measures like lock-downs, work from home policies, and income subsidies caused significant distortions in population statistics. For example,

- 1) During COVID, a significant portion of people worked from home, or stopped working temporarily. This caused a high unemployment rate. Now many of them are employed and have returned to their workplaces. This also impacts commuting patterns.
- 2) During COVID, a significant number of people lived in their cottages, vacation homes or with their relatives outside of the city and downtown areas. Now many of them have returned.
- 3) In 2020, government wage subsidy programs such as CERB and extended EI caused a sizable increase in the income of low income households. Now their income is back to the previous level/trend.

To mitigate these shortcomings caused by COVID-19, we have incorporated historical trends, post COVID surveys, and current year research and publications like Labour Force Survey from Statistics Canada into our 2023 updates of SuperDemographics. In particular, for Census 2021, Statistics Canada introduced many new variables, re-grouped some variables, and dropped variables which are no longer applicable or below population count thresholds. See below for a few examples.
